Itinerary

Day 1 My Tho – Ben Tre : To visit and learn village's Culture (Dinner)

Pick up at your place travel to My Tho - visit Vinh Trang Pagoda, one of ancient pagoda in The Mekong Delta. Take a river boat for a cruise along the river banks of The Mekong River. Boat to Ben Tre (Coconut Island), enter a small Que An canal where it homes more coconut palms than any other place in the country, visit farmer's traditional house built by coconut wood. Enjoy 5 sorts of fresh fruits. Mekong music show in the village (Lunch time). Cycle on the village road and see the garden's life. Boat trip again to the home stay along coconut gardens to home stay garden. Take fishing tools. The farmers will show you how to catch fish in small canals and learn to cook Vietnamese prawn pancake in the simple kitchen. Evening you will have dinner with Mekong family atmosphere. After the meal, take a light torch and walk along the riverbank to witness amazing sight of trees being lighted up by fireflies beside the canal banks. Go back to garden house – Home stay overnight.

Day 2 Cycling to visit Mekong Delta Gardens & Islands, Fish Farm (Breakfast/Lunch)

AM: Early morning cycling on the country road to visit fruit gardens, visit a small village market and learn about the morning countryside life of coconut island. Back to the homestay (Breakfast) - Boating to visit the fish farm on the Mekong River - local handicraft village - a traditional house on the island – Walk through Unicorn island. Visit the Bee garden on the island where farmers take honey from the fruit garden (You will be enjoying honey lemon tea and fruit sweets) or have a python photos taken, Come to visit a farmer house and learn how the people build the garden in The Mekong. Take Boat to go back to My Tho. Take a rowing boat to explore a small canal in nature.

PM: Stop at Bon Sai garden - lunch in the river restaurant. After that transfer back to Saigon.

Itinerary

Day 1 Cai Be Homestay (Dinner)

PM: Arrival Cai Be Floating Market. Take a boat trip to Vinh Long canals and fruit garden. Visit local primary school, Catholic Church, enjoy fruits and rowing boat tour in canals. Come to stay in the farmer house with a friendly family warm air. Walking to visit the An Binh village, Crocodile farm. You can visit the kitchen and learn how the farmers cook the local family foods. Enjoy local special foods for dinner. After dinner, a meeting will be arranged by family members and guests to talk about life and gardening. Homestay overnight in the garden.

Day 2 Cai Be Floating Market – Vinh Long Canals (Breakfast)

Morning: Watch the sunrise. Take a boat trip into the Vinh Long canals, the most interesting view in the area. Come up The Mekong River to Cai Be Floating market - Early morning activity at Cai Be floating market – The group can buy fruits and seeing fruits and vegetables strangely hanged on bamboo poles in front the boats. Come to visit the local 150 year old Phu Chau pagoda, the traditional handicrafts village in Cai Be; rice paper, pop rice cakes, coconut candy...you will be amazed by all the local products. Visit Mr.Kiet ancient house where you will learn more of the Mekong culture and art. Enjoy special local foods – Tour end.
