Day 1 Brunei Perth (BI67/0140-0700) - Ferguson Farmstay (Meals on Board/Lunch/Dinner)

Assemble at Brunei International Airport for your flight to Perth. Upon arrival meet and transfer to Ferguson Farm for checkin. Get ready for lots of farm activities especially created for children and their parents. We begin the day with milking the cow, then feeding baby calves. Next is collecting the eggs from the chickens and putting out food for the goats, ducks, guinea pigs, geese and rabbits. The pony ride follows. There is a tractor ride too. We visit the further part of the farm and see the bigger animals. The tractor ride is not scheduled every day, but everyone should have at least one ride during their stay. Enjoy the 2.5 Km walk trail, complete with seven bridges, seats, and a picnic area that offers spectacular views or trying catching yabbies and trout in the farms dam. Overnight at the Farm.

Day 2 Farmstay - City Tour -Cruise (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Early morning wakeup continue with our Far activities with a hearty farmstyle breakfast. Say "good bye" to the farm and "hello" Perth city. Perth became known worldwide as the "City of Lights" as city residents lit their house lights and streetlights as American astronaut John Glenn passed overhead while orbiting the earth on Friendship 7 in 1962. The city repeated its feat as Glenn passed overhead on the Space Shuttle in 1998. Overnight at King's Hotel or similar.

Day 3 Wildlife Park (Breakfast)

The Wildlife Park is a large area with enclosures for a huge variety of native Australian animals. The most popular exhibits include the kangaroos and koalas, the most well-known of Australia's unique marsupials. Other special moments include being able to hold a wombat (weighing around 20kg or 45 pounds), watching Tasmanian devils feed, or hearing a kookaburra laugh, or ride a camel which, although not native to Australia, now live wild in the northern desert areas of the country. After tour transfer to hotel and free at leisure for the rest of the day. Overnight at King's Hotel or similar.

Day 4 Full Day Tour Margaret River (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Discovered a place where you can explore world class wineries, old growth forests and miles and miles of unspoilt beaches. Western Australia's famous Margaret River Wine Region combines secluded beaches, old growth forests and wineries to create a truly unique holiday experience, producing wines from over 60 wineries, delicious cheeses, chocolate, olive oil and truffles throughout the region. Lunch and Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight at King's Hotel or similar.

Day 5 Full Day Fremantle Market (Breakfast)

Fremantle oozes a vibrant mix of cosmopolitan class, funky culture and warm, heritage charm. Known as the world's best preserved example of a 19th century port streetscape and boasting Western Australia's largest collection of heritage listed buildings, there is no doubt that Fremantle possesses a depth of character that cannot be replicated elsewhere. Its cappuccino strip is jammed packed with lively restaurants, streets are abuzz with shoppers and historical pubs brim with patrons from across the globe. The city's multicultural mix is most evident in its food and restaurants. Overnight at king's Hotel or similar.

Day 6 Perth Brunei (BI66 / 1810-2330) (Breakfast)

Free on your own to take an optional tour or do last minute shopping for souvenirs to bring home or purchase goods you have not been able to get. Checkout of hotel and transfer to Perth International Airport for flight home.
